Explanation of Escape Routes

The passengers and crew of any ship must be aware of the evacuation routes available to them from within the vessel. There are usually two types of evacuation route; primary and secondary.

Primary Evacuation Route The quickest and easiest way to the assembly/muster station or survival craft.

Secondary Evacuation Route A specially designated exit route for use when the Primary route is unusable.
