Safety signs are required to complement or expand the scope of officially designated signage. Many of the above signs will be required by various Registration and Classification Authorities to cover safety and life saving equipment.

With increasing numbers of new vessel and safety equipment appearing, special signage is always required. We are happy to manufacture signage to customers designs in the event of our standard range not meeting specific requirements (see page 57). Sign 4130 LJ is an example of this. Based on the IMO symbol, this sign neatly overcomes the problems associated with stowage of lifejackets in high speed ferry cabins.

Installation

All first aid points and first aid storage should be marked, as should emergency telephones and emergency stop buttons. Chemical carriers and vessels carrying hazardous cargoes should mark emergency showers and eye washes with the appropriate signs.
